Dear Parents,

I have been asked to inform parents that the new premises in North Downs Road, Chesdle Hulme, will not now be ready for the opening of the term on the 2nd September. As a result the boys will report to Moseley Hall as at present at between 9.30 and 9.45 a.m. on the first morning.

Will parents of the few boys who at present travel by school bus from Bramhall please note that on the first day of next term there will still be one bus but that we will share it with Chesdle County Grammar School for Girls. It will start at Grange Road, Bramhall at 9.45 a.m. and proceed via Bridge Lane, Fir Road, Robin's Lane, the centre of Bramhall and Oak Drive. On normal days it will leave Grange Road at 8 a.m.

It appears quite certain that we shall take over our new premises not later than half term, that is towards the end of October. While naturally we feel some disappointment at this comparatively short delay, there is no doubt that we are getting a very fine building which has in it some very interesting features. It is much better that we should take the premises over when they are absolutely ready.
